

VIDEO MONITORING SYSTEMS

Video monitoring is an effective and efficient way to keep in touch with seniors. Through a secure connection, the monitoring station, family members, or caregivers can keep in visual contact. The system can even be programmed to send a video signal in case of an emergency.

SMOKE/CO DETECTORS In the event of an emergency, these detectors signal the monitoring station to dispatch the local fire department.

DOOR/WINDOW CONTACTS Motion detectors or door sensors can be programmed to signal when a door is opened or motion is detected within the home.
