

With the simple push of a button on a wrist band or pendant, a caring, professionally trained representative at the central monitoring station will answer the client through the two-way, tabletop PERS console and respond to the call for help. The central monitoring station will then dispatch the appropriate help and stay on the phone until help arrives — an ambulance, neighbor, family or friends.

For added safety and security, the *SafetyChoice* PERS can be expanded to monitor up to 16 additional safety devices. These include motion detectors, window/door contacts and a pressure-sensitive floor mat that can provide home security or monitor people who wander, such as those with Alzheimer's or other dementia-related conditions. Smoke and carbon monoxide detectors also can be added to the PERS system.

Manage Medicine

he Comfort Keepers SafetyChoice<sup>™</sup> Medication Management System helps seniors simplify the sometimes complicated process of managing and dispensing prescriptions. It organizes medicines and provides reminders for each dose through automated voice alerts, messages on a display screen and flashing lights.

Research indicates that approximately 40% of people entering nursing homes do so because they are unable to self-medicate in their homes. In addition, 30% of all hospital admissions for people over age 65 are directly attributable to missed doses or overdoses of medication.

To assure safety, the Medication Management System's locking storage compartment limits access to one dose of pills at a time. The system holds up to 60 medication cups, each capable of containing 20 to 25 pills and supplements. It provides up to a 40-day supply. If a dose is missed, the Medication Management System makes an automated call to the client's contact list. If there is no response, an alert is sent to the monitoring station, which makes a call to the client or caregiver.

This easy-to-operate, cost-effective dispensing unit enables individuals to take their medicine on schedule in order to promote optimal health. And it helps them to maintain independent living at home for as long as possible.

Accessories to the Comfort Keepers SafetyChoice<sup>™</sup> Personal Emergency Response System (PERS) are available to extend safety and security. They enhance home security, monitor doors/windows and detect movement in designated areas to protect loved ones who wander due to Alzheimer's or other dementia-related conditions.

When the accessories are activated, they send a wireless signal to the PERS unit, which then signals the PERS system to contact the central monitoring station for response.





#### DOOR & WINDOW CONTACTS

When a door or window is opened while the system is turned on, contacts set off an alarm in the home and send a signal to the central monitoring station. The station will call people on the subscriber's responder list to advise them of the situation. These units can be turned off during the day.



#### PRESSURE-SENSITIVE FLOOR MAT

This wireless floor mat may be placed next to a bed or other designated areas of the home. An alarm sounds when the mat is stepped on, signaling that a senior is out of bed or in an area that may be unsafe. In addition, a signal is sent to the central monitoring station to notify designated responders.



#### MOTION DETECTORS

Installed in a central area of the house, infrared motion detectors, when activated and tripped, signal the central monitoring station. The station will call the residence to verify whether the alarm was set off by an authorized person, then, if necessary, call designated responders. When used to monitor the movement of loved ones who wander, the system sends an alarm to the caregiver's computer. If the alarm system is not reset, the central monitoring station personnel will follow instructions established by the client. The motion detector can be turned off during the day.



#### SMOKE & CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS

In the event of an emergency, these detectors will signal the central monitoring station to dispatch the local fire department. Through the two-way communication feature of the PERS unit, voice contact will be made to make certain the client and caregiver know of the situation and leave the residence.
